



Maximize Bulk Storage: Mobile Shelving

The Challenge

A leading auction house in New York had a problem— How to maximize their short-term storage capacity. Located in prestigious downtown Manhattan, the house was faced with storing more items at their warehouse location, changing their workflow, or moving. Many thousands of dollars of valuable items were being stored in static racking, and they were out of space. During busy times, there was considerable risk of damage to priceless items. In addition, the house was spending high premiums per square foot on access aisles to static shelving.



The Solution

The local dealer suggested a plan for the basement storage area: Mobilize the existing racking on Mizer carriages. A custom solution was devised, producing carriages in 13 foot sections to result **in the 82 foot long mobile ranges pictured above.** Due to Mizer's **Balanced-Drive** design, the carriages respond with zero yaw and minimal access latency. After two years of use, the system has functioned with no maintenance required to date. The house was able to bring more items from its Long Island City warehouse to the basement of the main facility in Manhattan, 2 floors below grade. More space was created, alleviating the cost of storage, and mitigating concerns of damage.
