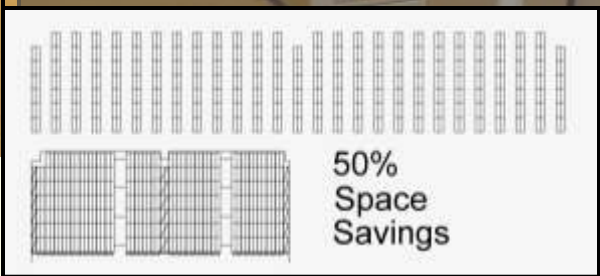
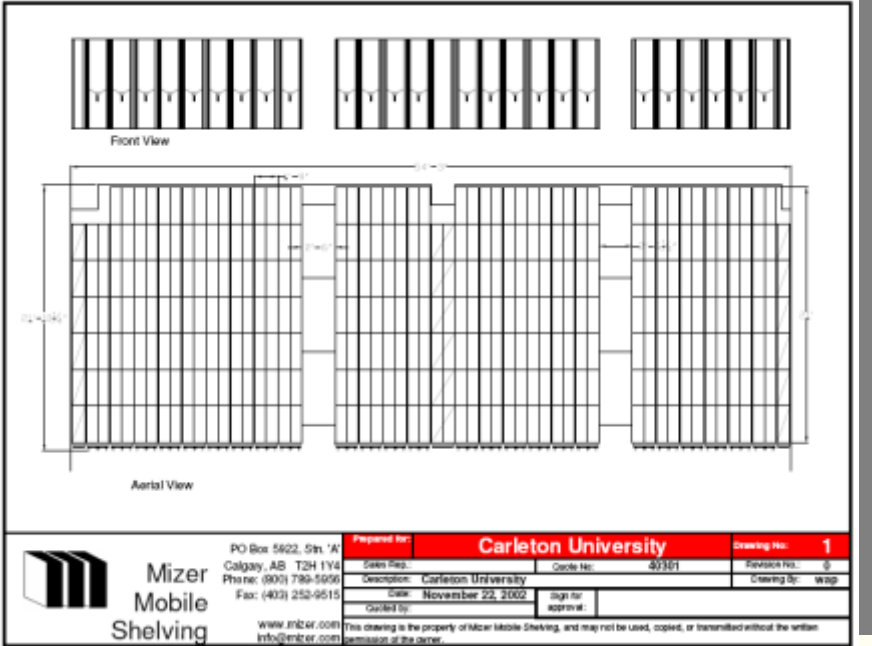




Mizer Mobile Systems: University Library Application

A major Ottawa, Canada University required space for their book collection. The collection was accessed rarely, so it was an ideal application for compact mobile shelving. The system consultant capitalized on this by planning only two access aisles for all 25 mobile ranges. This maximized the space available.



Cantilever library shelving was used on the Mizer mobile carriages. When installed, the library was able to store its collection without having to allocate further space to storage. The collection would have required 2,358 square feet to store, if static library shelving was used. But using Mizer carriages, the entire collection compacted into 1,189 square feet. This represents a 50.4% savings, half the space required with static shelving.
