

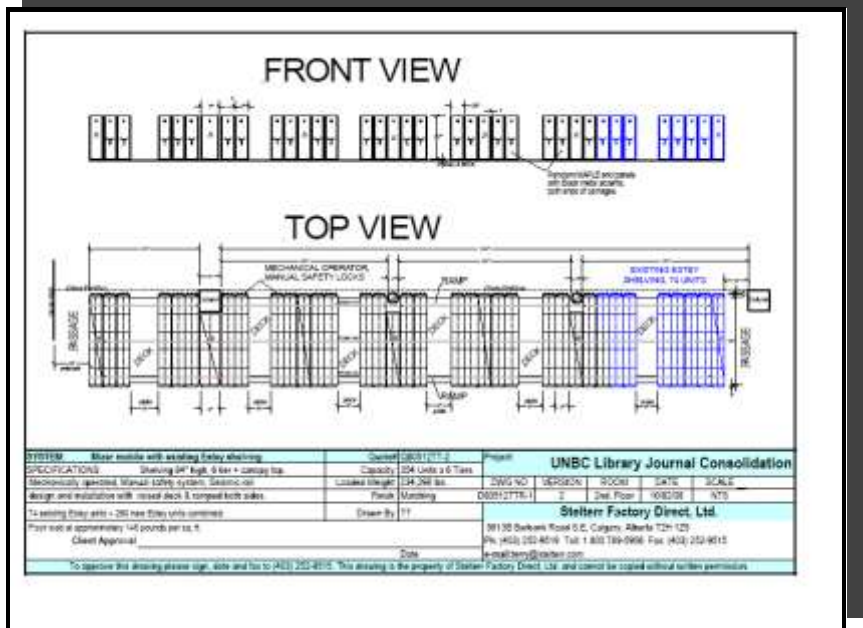


University Journal Collection: Re-use existing shelving

The Challenge

1. How can you consolidate the journal collection into substantially less space than it currently occupies, while actually expanding the number of volumes it contains?
2. Could existing book stacks be incorporated and utilized in the plan to save money, while also reducing waste?

These were the challenging questions facing the Geoffrey R. Weller Library, located on the beautiful UNBC campus in Prince George, British Columbia.



The Solution

Mizer mobile shelving was the solution for both questions.

1. The Mizer system enabled the library to compact the book stacks into substantially less space and still allowed for growth in the number of bound journals.
2. Existing book stacks were seamlessly incorporated into the Mizer mobile shelving, saving money and reducing the potential amount of waste materials.

To facilitate multiple user access at any one time, the compact book stacks were grouped in 6 separate blocks.
